I have a particular interest in protecting places like Meshanticut Lake from invasive aquatic species and declining water quality. I would like to see the state provide communities with stronger technical and financial support for early detection and removal of invasive species, stormwater improvements, and restoration of local waterways before problems become more difficult and expensive to solve.

Narragansett Bay is one of Rhode Island's greatest resources, but protecting it requires us to think about the entire system that feeds it, including the neighborhood lake down the street.
