We need to preserve wetlands protections and make stormwater management a state priority. I also believe we should build climate resilience into every water-infrastructure investment. When the state funds a sewer, wastewater plant, culvert, stormwater system, or water-supply project, climate projections, including sea-level rise, heavier rainfall, flooding, and saltwater intrusion, to be part of the design criteria from the beginning. We also need to aggressively tackle PFAs. We also need to increase and stabilize dedicated funding to protect the watershed and the bay rather than relying primarily on occasional bond initiatives.
